Dear Intel® FPGA Customer,

We thank you for your patronage of Intel's FPGA products and value our relationship with you. We are very happy to share with you this supply status update for some externally manufactured Intel FGAs products.

We are seeing supply improvements and will be taking nine product families off allocation, effective July 17, 2023. After this date, no Intel FPGA products will be on supply driven allocation. The affected product families are shown in Table 1 below. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the timing of this action and to ensure you work with your PSG distributor for more details regarding your orders.

Products coming off allocation

- **What:** Effective July 17, 2023 (PST), the product families in Table 1 below are off allocation.
 - Starting July 17, 2023, Intel distribution partners will manage all customer shipment commits for all Intel FPGA and Intel® Enpirion® Power products; no products will remain on allocation.
 - All backlog in place now, but not scheduled as part of the current allocation cycle or placed before July 17 will be scheduled by channel partners by July 18, 2023.
 - All orders placed after July 17, 2023, will be scheduled by channel partners in accordance with Intel's published lead time guidance.
